Candidates must be a citizen of the United States or a permanent resident alien who is eligible for, and has applied for citizenship at least one year prior to filing the application for employment. Must be at least 21 years of age by date of appointment and possess a high school diploma or equivalent with related college course work as well as a valid California Driver's License with a satisfactory driving record. Candidates must also be of good moral character, free of any felony convictions and any physical, emotional or medical condition which might adversely affect the exercise of the powers of a peace officer.

Academy Graduates must have graduated from a POST approved Law Enforcement Academy within the last 3 years (or have a requalification certificate dated within the last 3 years). Lateral candidates must have a POST certificate and not have been separated more than 3 years from a law enforcement position in the State of California.
