Subject: Release of *Anti-Reproductive-Rights Crimes Guidelines* for Law Enforcement

In January 2009, Penal Code Section 13519.15 was enacted and required the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) to prepare guidelines establishing standard procedures for law enforcement agencies in the investigation and reporting of cases involving anti-reproductive-rights crimes. The guidelines were designed as an overview to allow the reader to consider a systematic approach in investigating anti-reproductive-rights crimes and in creating an agency specific plan for handling cases involving these crimes. Also included within this document are mandatory procedures for the statistical reporting requirements to the Department of Justice.
