California is home to the largest court system in the United States, with more than 2,000 judicial officers and 18,000 court employees serving more than 34 million people each year. The courts range from criminal and civil courts to juvenile and family courts, all with one thing in common: custodial personnel.

This telecourse focuses on specific situations-- many based on actual cases-- where custodial personnel training and preparation can be vital to maintaining security for everyone involved in the court process. The program features insights statewide from court personnel, judges, supervisors and command staff, and members of the media on topics including: the legal authority and responsibility of court security personnel; the value of policies, procedures, and planning; elements of safety and protection; the public's perception of the courts; and, the importance of communication.
