Electronic and projectile weapons can provide the peace officer force option tools that, when used properly, provide safety for officers and subjects. When officers understand these weapons and what they can do, the more effective they become in arresting or controlling a combative subject.

This telecourse familiarizes officers with commonly used electronic and projectile weapons, raises officers' awareness of these weapons, their use, effectiveness, limitations, and necessary pre-planning. The program also addresses legal and liability aspects of using these weapons and emphasizes the importance of proper documentation and post-use care on subjects.
