

The Intelligence Process

This program underscores the vital role field officers play in providing essential pieces of information on which all "intelligence product" is based. Specific segments reinforce the importance of the field officer in gathering intelligence. Several key questions from field officers regarding the intelligence process and its practical application are included:

- What is the difference between *intelligence* and *information*?
- What kind of information is needed?
- How does intelligence contribute to officer safety?
- How can I access intelligence professionals directly?
- What is "data mining" and why is it important?
- How can a departmental intelligence collection plan be built?
