



Interrogation Techniques

This second program in the two-part series focuses on effective techniques for interrogating a suspect. As with the Interview Techniques telecourse, this program uses a sexual assault scenario to illustrate key aspects of interrogation (see segments below), then provides the conclusions of three more scenarios-- a domestic violence call, robbery, and drive-by shooting-- to show proper interrogation techniques. Common errors with interrogations are also illustrated.
