



Leadership and Supervision

2 Hours - Telecourse DVD

Explores the moment-by-moment nature of leadership in law enforcement and underscores the premise that leadership on the job is less taught than it is absorbed. The program also makes the distinction that managers are people "who do things right," while leaders are people who "do the right thing." Ten leadership principles are presented, including: 1) Connecting, 2) Creating, 3) Communicating, 4) Confronting, 5) Commending, 6) Confessing, 7) Caring, 8) Coaching, 9) Character, and 10) Commanding.

The DVD program offers both linear and nonlinear viewing options:

1. Play telecourse in its entirety (2 hours).
2. Select among eight telecourse segments:
 - Pre-Test (7 min.)
 - Facilitator (9 min.)
 - Vision (10 min.)
 - Mentoring (12 min.)
 - Experience (9 min.)
 - Direction (13 min.)
 - Teaching (13 min.)
 - Inspiring Others (6 min.)
3. Select among eight telecourse interaction segments:
 - Answers to the Pre-Test
 - How do leaders approach problems?
 - How does "vision" relate to supervision and leadership?
 - When is supervisory intervention appropriate?
 - What is a supervisor's role in a pursuit?
 - How does a leader communicate confidence?
 - What is a leader's role as a counselor and mentor?
 - How does technical competence relate to leadership?
