


Refresher First Aid/CPR Training Requirements 2015-2017

If training is completed:

| Prerequisites: (if applicable) | Refresher training with the prior content only required the student to first attend: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First Aid/CPR | Refresher training with the new content requires the student to first attend either: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First Aid/CPR and First Aid/CPR Update <u>or</u> • First Aid/CPR/AED | Refresher training with the new content requires the student to first attend either: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First Aid/CPR and First Aid/CPR Update <u>or</u> • First Aid/CPR/AED |

*For the purposes of this guide, “prior” requirements or content refers to the 2010 AHA guidelines as defined in Title 22 prior to April 1, 2015. “New” requirements or content refers to the 2015 AHA guidelines as defined in Title 22 effective April 1, 2015 which includes new content for Public Safety First Aid training (e.g., AED, Psychological Emergencies, Assisted Epinephrine Administration, EMS integration/Active Shooter).
