**PC 832 Arrest and Firearms Course**  
The PC 832 Arrest and Firearms Course (PC 832 Course) is the minimum training standard for California peace officers. All peace officers are required to complete this course prior to exercising the powers of a peace officer. This training may be met by successful completion of a basic training course (e.g., Regular Basic Course, Specialized Investigators' Basic Course or the Module III of the Regular Basic Course - Modular Format) or as a separate stand-alone certified course. The Modular Format of the RBC is delivered in a three-part instructional sequence that coincides with the three California reserve peace officer levels. Module III student workbooks are divided into 19 Learning Domains. Module II student workbooks are divided into 17 Learning Domains. Module I student workbooks are divided into 27 Learning Domains. 





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**BASIC COURSE EXPANDED COURSE OUTLINE EXEMPLARS**

The expanded course outline exemplars provided below are intended to assist Basic Course Presenters in developing expanded course outlines to the third level of detail pursuant to POST regulation 1053 (a) (4).

The first two levels of detail as shown in the exemplars are an exact reiteration of the Training and Testing Specifications for all 42 learning domains found in the Basic Course. The presenter is obligated to provide an Expanded Course Outline minimally to the third level of detail and additional levels as warranted. The main source document for the third level of detail is the student workbook and presenters may use other source documents. All agency specific learning objectives must be minimally listed to the third level of detail.

**Instructions for using the Basic Course Outline Exemplars**

- The exemplar should be saved to the user's computer file to enable editing the document.
- The third, fourth or fifth levels of detail must be inserted into the document by the presenter.
- All presenter-specific learning objectives must be included minimally to the third level of detail.
- Once completed the presenter must save the file as an RTF.
- The final RTF file can be included in the course certification package and submitted to POST via EDI.

Each exemplar maintains the formatting provided in the Training and Testing Specifications for Peace Officer Basic Courses (TTS) verbatim which ensures consistency between the TTS and the various courses.

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

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**Training and Testing Specifications for Peace Officer Basic Courses**

The increasingly diverse challenges and changing service demands confronting law enforcement require that the content and instructional methodologies of peace officer training be regularly evaluated and updated. Effective initial training is crucial if an officer is to acquire the critical knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to render high quality service.

The Training and Testing Specifications list the minimum, mandated curriculum and testing for the POST-mandated basic courses. The curriculum for each basic course listed below is divided into individual topics, called Learning Domains. The Learning Domains contain the minimum required foundational information for given subjects and appear in sequential order. Each Learning Domain includes descriptions of learning needs, lists of related learning objectives, any required tests and instructional activities, and minimum hourly requirements. The Training and Testing Specifications are updated twice a year, or as needed, and coincide with the educational objectives (EO's) listed in the student workbooks used by academies.


