The nomination period for the 2009 POST Excellence in Training Award is open. The award (previously known as the Governor's Award for Excellence in Peace Officer Training) has been given by the Commission since 1994. The criteria for the award have remained the same since its inception.

Nominations are accepted for this premiere award in three distinct categories. The categories are:

- Individual Achievement
- Organizational Achievement
- Lifetime Achievement

All nominations must be postmarked by **Tuesday, December 1, 2009**. POST will return nominations postmarked after this date to the nominator.

Award criteria includes: 1) innovation, 2) impact, and 3) previous recognition.
