Please welcome Scott Loggins, POST's new Assistant Executive Director, Standards and Development Division.

Scott started his law enforcement career with the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department in 1988, serving as a Corrections Deputy, Field Training Officer, and Detective. In 1997, he was promoted to Sergeant and served as a Custody Supervisor, Administrative Sergeant, Patrol Supervisor, and Academy Director.

In 2003, Scott became a Lieutenant and served as a Watch and Assistant Commander at the Rio Cosumnes Correctional Center and Assistant Commander in the Central Division before his final assignment with the County as the Watch Commander of Field Services.

Scott earned his Master's Degree in Emergency Services in 2007 from the California State University, Long Beach (CSULB) to compliment his CSULB Bachelor's Degree in Occupational Studies from 2005.

In 2011, Scott joined POST as a Law Enforcement Consultant in the Basic Training Bureau (BTB) managing Basic Course Certification Reviews. Within two years, Scott was promoted to Chief of BTB and has provided management leadership for the Bureau since this appointment. As the BTB Chief, he has been instrumental in providing consultative services in training and education program development for compliance to State laws and POST regulations.

In his new capacity, Scott will be overseeing the Training Delivery and Compliance, Training Program Services, and Standards, Evaluation, and Research Bureaus.
