

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In this rulemaking, the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) is amending an incorporated by reference document, POST Basic Courses Test Management and Security to restrict the use of body cameras during the administration of confidential POST-developed test material. Additionally, POST adds information as to when an instructor is not able to proctor a POST-developed text. POST is also adding a secure web browser contract for online testing and clarifying when test material must be maintained in secure student files.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 7/1/2018.
