Subject: **Changes to the Domestic Violence Update Courses on the POST Learning Portal**

SB1331, which became effective January 1, 2019, requires that domestic violence courses include procedures and techniques for assessing lethality or signs of lethal violence in domestic violence situations.

Information about SB1331 and the lethality assessment form can be found on the [POST Website](#) and in the [Domestic Violence Update Center](#) on the Portal. In addition, the following changes will be made to the three self-paced courses on the POST Learning Portal effective **April 2, 2019**:

Domestic Violence Response (CCN 9180-25583) will be offline and unavailable on the Portal. An updated course with learning and evaluation activities for lethality assessment will be added to the Portal under a new course control number (CCN) at a date to be determined.

Domestic Violence: It's Your Call Vols I & II (CCN 9180-25580 & 25581) will be offline and unavailable on the Portal permanently.

Officers who have started any of the three courses should make time to complete them before April 1, 2019. Otherwise, they can complete the new course when it is added to the Portal.

Officers who have completed any of the three courses between January 1, 2019 – March 31, 2019, will be able to complete a supplemental activity, to be posted at a later date, to meet the requirements for the Domestic Violence Update training mandate.
