Subject: **AB 392 and Peace Officer Use of Force Standards: POST Video and Other Resources Now Available**

The POST AB 392 informational video is back online as of November 8, 2019.

By way of background, in August 2019 AB 392 was signed into law. Effective January 1, 2020, the bill will change legal standards for California peace officers' use of force, including justifiable homicide and deadly force.

In an effort to assist California agencies and their personnel with understanding and preparing for the changes, POST has developed various resources including "AB 392: California's New Use of Force Standards: What You Need to Know" video. The video was taken offline on October 28, 2019, as the information presented between minutes 04:00 – 07:00 was not consistent with the new law. The video has since been corrected.
