- E. The Advisory Committee Chair called for Committee Member reports.
  - Vice Chair Baron:  
CCLEA has been involved in local area elections. Two of note are the Los Angeles County Sheriff's position and the Orange County Sheriff's position, CCLEA was party in and taking an interest in.
  - Member Moore:  
State Sheriffs has been discussing the latest Superior Court decision regarding charter cities and the enforcement of SB 54 and the requirements thereto.  
  
SB 1421 and what the responses are going to be, and how CSSA is going to be able to comply with the rules and regulations.  
  
Body camera footage to be released within 45-days. Have been looking at some different options and how those are going to be affected, and then how agencies are going to have to modify policies and procedures.
  - Member Brown:  
CADA and POST staff have been working together to design some contemporary curriculum to weave into the police academies of the future.
  - Member Beitey:  
As of July 1<sup>st</sup>, the California Community College System has modified their funding mechanism for community colleges.
  - Member Waltz:  
CAPTO is growing right now and has had some large chapter meetings in the Central Valley, 20-30 training managers and the POST regional consultant is usually able to attend the meetings, and that has been a very good benefit to the group.

- Chair Spagnoli:  
CPOA will have the third presentation of its Leadership Development Program coming up. It's available if anyone is interested. It is modeled after SLI, and it is focused on the line officer.
