**1009 Academy Instructor Certificate Program (AICP)**

**1009(a) The Instructor Certificate Program**

*[1009(a)(1)-(7) remains unchanged]*

(8) Academy Directors, Coordinators, and Recruit Training Officers (Academy Staff) assigned pursuant to Regulation 1052 may provide incidental instruction as needed to supplement and clarify content taught in the formalized setting, excluding instructional content identified in Regulation 1070, which requires specialized instruction, and shall expressly preclude academy staff from utilizing this language to bypass the AICP.
