Modifications to the Text of Proposed Regulations and Addition of Documents and Information to Rulemaking File for Regulation 1005, 1007, and 1008 *Training & Testing Specifications for Peace Officers Basic Courses* (OAL File Notice Number Z-2019-1031-02 and POST Bulletin Number 2019-34)

The Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) has revised the proposed regulations for Training & Testing Specifications for Peace Officer Basic Courses. The original notice of proposed regulatory action for this topic was published on November 15, 2019; all related documents are available on [POST's Regulatory Actions](#).

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) is providing notice of changes made to the proposed regulation section 1005, 1007, and 1008. The changes include amending the following document incorporated by reference: Training & Testing Specifications for Peace Officer Basic Courses (Rev. 4/2020).

The attached Training & Testing Specifications have been modified to amend Learning Domain 20 learning need IV, E (page 20-4) changed public to peace due to revised Penal Code section 196. Learning Domain 35 exercise test D (page 35-12) positions was inadvertently deleted.
