

**ADDENDUM - INITIAL STATEMENT OF REASONS**  
**Reimbursements for Training**  
**Commission Regulation 1015**

---

At the February 13, 2020 meeting, the Commission approved proposed amendments to Regulation 1015 – Reimbursements for Training.

Further review of the content revealed additional changes were necessary to ensure consistency with existing language and clarity of the increase in the reimbursement rate structures for both the Regular Basic Course (Standard Format) and the Regular Basic Course (Modular Format, Intensive Presentation Only). Justification for these changes are presented below.

**Justification for Proposed Revisions**

**Regulation 1015 (d)(2)(A)**

- The proposed revision is necessary to address the increase in local assistance budget for FY 19-20 which POST received from the State and to comply with ever increasing law enforcement agency needs.
- Under the Regular Basic Course (Standard Format), changing the number of maximum weeks to equal 20 is necessary in order to reach a maximum of 800 reimbursable hours. (20 weeks X 40 hours = 800 maximum hours).
- Under the Regular Basic Course (Modular Format, Intensive Presentation Only), changing the maximum number of weeks/hours for Module III, II and I is necessary as all three Modules together must equal a total of 20 maximum weeks in order to reach a maximum of 800 reimbursable hours. With the revised week/hour break down for each Module, it will equal out and match the same total of the Regular Basic Course (Standard Format) and ensure consistency between the two Formats.
