Modifications to the Text of Proposed Regulations and Addition of Document and Information to Rulemaking File for Division 2 of Title 11 of the California Code of Regulations, Regulation 1015, Reimbursements for Training (OAL Notice Number Z-2020-0324-08 and POST Bulletin Number 2020-16)

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c) and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) is providing notice of modifications to regulation section 1015.
