APPLICATION MATERIALS

The Angels Camp Police Department is seeking a full-time Police Officer to join our team.

Salary range is \$4,295 to \$5,221 per month, depending upon experience.

*Lateral Signing Bonus- \$2,500 at time of hire + \$2,500 after successful completion of probation + \$5,000 after 2 years of employment = \$10,000 total

*Academy Graduate Signing Bonus- \$2,500 after successful completion of probation

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION

Performs sworn law enforcement and crime prevention duties involved in the protection of life and property; performs a variety of technical and administrative tasks in support of law enforcement services and activities; and performs other related duties as assigned.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

May include, but are not limited to the following:

Patrol the City in an automobile or on foot for the prevention of crime and the enforcement of traffic laws and regulations; issue citations; perform security patrols, traffic control, investigations; administer first aid and request medical attention when necessary.

Investigate crimes including felonies, misdemeanors, and City ordinances; conduct follow-up investigations of crimes; seek out and interview victims, witnesses, and suspects; search crime scenes for clues and evidence; collect, package, and preserve evidence.

Detect, pursue, apprehend and arrest or detain persons involved in crimes or misconduct; arrest subjects; transport prisoners.



Perform crowd control, regulate vehicle flow at incidents or congested situations.

Perform duties in conformance with Federal, State, County, and City laws, regulations, and ordinances.

Attend and successfully complete required training including firearm qualification.

Prepare a variety of written reports; operate a mobile data computer.

Make public appearances and presentations to actively develop and foster community partnerships; demonstrate leadership within the organization and community.

Appear and testify in court.

Perform other related duties as required.

KNOWLEDGE OF

Police methods and procedures including patrol, crime prevention, traffic control, investigation and identification techniques.

Criminal law and criminal procedures with particular reference to the apprehension, arrest and custody of persons, rules of evidence pertaining to the search and seizure and preservation of evidence.

Interview techniques and public contact techniques.

Office methods and techniques.

ABILITY TO

Communicate effectively, orally and in writing.

Write clear, concise and comprehensive reports.

Read and understand department policies, instruction, laws and regulations.

Interpret and apply laws and regulations.

Learn standard broadcasting procedures of a police radio system.

Gather and evaluate facts and evidence.

Draw logical conclusions and make proper recommendations.

Qualify in the use of firearms.

Learn the use and care of equipment.

Meet and deal with the public tactfully and effectively.

Establish and maintain effective working relationships with those contacted in the course of work.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Equivalent to graduation from the twelfth (12) grade.

Successful completion of a POST certified police academy within the last three years, **OR** employed in a qualifying peace officer position, within the last three years.

Must possess a valid California Class C driver license or higher.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

All applications received will be reviewed for accuracy, completeness and job-related qualifications. The most qualified applicants will be invited to participate in an oral interview.

Finalists must successfully pass a thorough background investigation, medical, and psychological examination.
