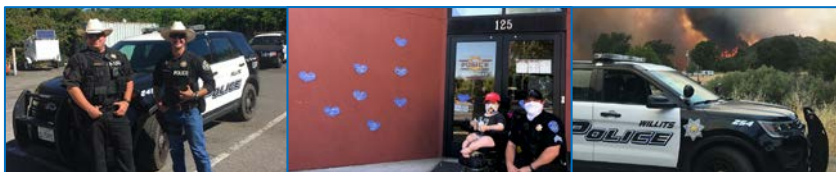

TYPICAL DUTIES:

Willits Police Officers with the City of Willits are required to perform a full range of police functions, as specified in the complete job description, including, but not limited to, patrol of the City in a police car, on foot, or on a bicycle; answer calls for service, complete crime reports, complete investigations, submit reports to the District Attorney's Office for filings, prepare search warrants, and testify in court; receive, search, process, fingerprint, and transport prisoners; and work on computers. As a strong community-oriented policing department, police officers are required to respond to public speaking engagements, maintain contact and work with citizens regarding potential public safety problems and preserve good relationships with the general public.
